As you see from the quality values, continue harvesting without delay for high quality alfalfa forage. Fields sampled for quality monitoring are 2nd or 3rd year production fields. On average we lose roughly 4-5 RFV points per day, depending on temperatures. PEAQ RFVs are about 15 RFV points higher than forage coming out of storage.
