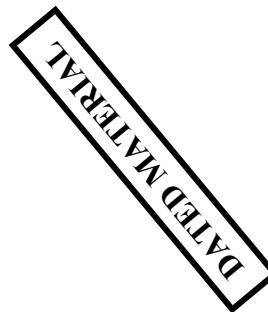

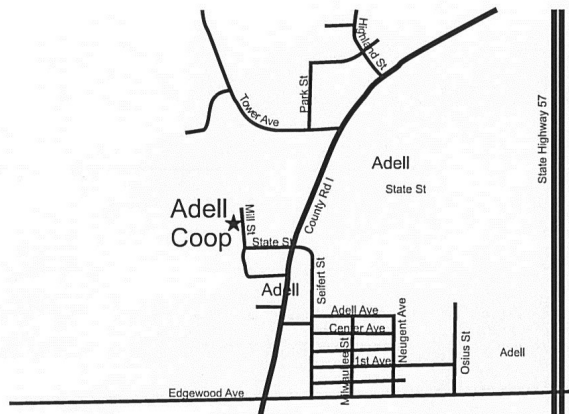

## Terms of Sale

1. All hay must be at the auction site no later than 9:30 a.m. on date of sale. Late arrivals will be addressed at the discretion of supervising Forage Council Board Member.
2. Hay will be offered for sale in order of arrival at market site on sale date.
3. Terms of sale: Cash, Approved Checks, Credit Cards—3.5% service charge on credit card sales.
4. Sales commence at 10:00 a.m. sharp subject to local conditions.
5. Hay will be sold by weight or bale.
6. Consigner is responsible for quality and conditions of hay. Any consigner found to be deliberately misrepresenting or altering their product shall be barred from further participation in the sales.
7. All sales F.O.B. auction site unless other arrangements are made.
8. Sellers must assist buyers to reload hay at market site if needed.
9. Buyers will be asked to verify credit.
10. A bill of sale or disclaimer is required.
11. Minimum sale lot will be 40 regular sized squares.
12. Commission rate of 6% or minimum of \$5.00 per load for both hay and straw.
