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| Committee Name | Sheboygan County 4-H Horse & Pony Committee |
| Purpose | <p>To organize and conduct 4-H Horse & Pony Project county-wide meetings, events and business.</p> <p>Members will assist committee work by helping the committee identify a goal, develop a plan of action, implement the plan, and evaluate the outcome.</p> |
| Success Criteria | <p>Each committee member has the opportunity to develop skills by participating in committee work.</p> <p>Committee reports to larger group regularly.</p> <p>Committee members must be active enrolled, certified 4-H volunteer leaders or 4-H members.</p> |
| Responsibilities | <p>Participate in meetings of the committee.</p> <p>Become informed on issues or business to be discussed. Express opinions clearly and allow others to express theirs. Accept responsibilities and share the work load.</p> <p>Accept decisions of the majority. Fulfill committee assignments.</p> <p>Report back to larger group.</p> |
| Time Required | <p>Time for committee meetings (meetings are commonly the 4th Monday monthly) 6:00 pm for youth committee and 6:30 pm for full committee.</p> <p>Time to carry out committee assignments.</p> |
