BLUE RIBBON SMALL ANIMAL AUCTION SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

DESCRIPTION:

Scholarship(s): number and amount to be determined yearly.

ELIGIBILITY:

- a. At least 2 years consecutive in one of the four projects: goats, poultry, rabbits or cavy
- b. Must be a senior in high school.
- c. Must be a member of either 4-H or FFA for at least 4 years; may be combination of either organization.

REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Two letters of recommendation:
 1. **Project Leader** (goat, poultry, rabbit or cavy) or FFA Advisor – example: (quality of project work).
 2. One from any other source – example: (employer, teacher, 4-H leader other than project applying for).
- b. **All applicants must be interviewed.**
- c. Must be used at an accredited school where the student must enroll and complete the first fall semester after graduation from high school
- d. Must show proof of acceptance by the school you will be attending while using the scholarship (required only after you've been selected).

COMMENTS:

- a. ALL FORM MUST BE RECEIVED BY April 10, 2020. Send to Extension - Sheboygan County, 5 University Dr., Attn: BRSA, Sheboygan, WI 53073. Interviews will be held at the Extension - Sheboygan County Office on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 starting at 7:00 p.m. Applicants will be notified of their interview time. - b. Applications may be picked up at any of the following:
 - A project leader in the cavy, goat, poultry, or rabbit project
 - At the Extension - Sheboygan County Office
 - High School Guidance Office
- c. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school or the school and the recipient after completion of the first successful semester of education at the post-secondary level.
