Sheboygan County 4-H General Livestock Committee

Guidelines/By-laws

I. <u>Position Qualifications – Committee Members</u>

- 1. Work well with youths and adults.
- 2. Be familiar with the goals of the 4-H livestock projects.
- 3. Active or interested in the county 4-H livestock projects.
- 4. There will be six adult members, two from each species that has a youth actively involved in a specific species.
- 5. There will be five-six youth members, age 13 up to age 18 (age as of January 1 of current year).
- 6. Members will serve a two year term, eligible for a second consecutive term.

II. Purpose and Scope

- 1. Encompass all 4-H livestock activities.
- 2. Coordinate and schedule educational activities.
- 3. Improve, foster, promote and develop the objectives of the livestock projects, that is:
 - a. Develop an appreciation of livestock production and it's importance in the economy of the community, state and nation.
 - b. Learn the application and use of sound business principles as they apply to the operation and management of the livestock project.
 - c. Recognize the importance of patience, kindness and understanding in handling livestock and fellow exhibitors.
 - d. Obtain knowledge and skills in livestock production to be successful in establishing and/or maintaining a livestock project.
- 4. Maintain regular communication with Sheboygan County 4-H Youth Development Educator and FFA organizations within Sheboygan County.
- 5. Be accessible to 4-H project and FFA members and parents as a resource and listener.

III. Elections

- 1. Committee will appoint a nominating committee member, which consists of exiting members, from each species.
- 2. Recommend two nominations for each open position.
- 3. Elections will be held in September of each year. One ballot per 4-H/FFA project member, one per project leader and one per FFA Advisor will be mailed.
- 4. New committee members will assume position in October.
- 5. Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer will be elected at the end o October meeting by the elected committee.
- 6. Vacancy on the committee shall be voted by the livestock committee to fill or not to fill, based on the duration of term left. It will be a general rule to fill vacancies of six months or greater and not to fill vacancies of less than six months.

- 7. A vacancy on the committee shall be filled for the unexpired term by a person elected by the majority of the remaining members of the committee.
- 8. Six members will be elected each year. Of the 6, 3 members will be adults, and 3 will be youth. Two members for each species, 1 adult and 1 youth, will be elected each year.

IV. <u>Committee Meetings</u>

- 1. Regular meetings will be held at least four times annually.
- 2. Special meetings can be called, as needed. There will be a seven day notice prior to the meeting. The notice is to include the specific reason for the meeting.
- 3. A quorum of a meeting shall consist of six (6) members.
- 4. The privilege of holding office, introducing motions, debating and voting shall be limited to members of the committee.
- 5. Roberts Rules of Order shall be followed by the committee.
- 6. The Sheboygan County 4-H Youth will act in an advisory role.
- 7. Individuals wishing to address the Livestock Committee at a meeting should notify the chairperson or a committee member three days prior to the meeting of their desire to be on the agenda.

V. <u>Amendments</u>

1. Amendments to these guidelines/by-laws can be made at any committee meeting by a vote of the members present and voting, provided notice of the proposed amendment was given at the previous committee meeting.

**The election of 1993 specified; two adults and one youth would serve a one year term, two youth and one adult will serve a two year term. This process is a one time process to allow the election of three members each year.

***The election of 2001 specified; 1 beef youth, 1 sheep youth, and 1 swine adult to serve a one year term; 1 beef adult, 1 beef youth, 1 sheep adult, 1 sheep youth, 1 swine adult, and 1 swine youth representative to serve a two year term. This process is a one time process to allow the election of 6 members (1 youth and 1 adult from each species) each year for a two year term.
