80th Anniversary of Franklin HCE

The Franklin Club Sheboygan County Homemakers was formed in 1939. There were 26 members. The club belonged to the North Plymouth Center. We are now the Franklin HCE with 11 members. We are in District IV.

The original roots of the club actually started in 1924 in Howards Grove then moved to Franklin when the President and most other members lived in Franklin. Sheboygan County had no county agent at this time, but were advised by other county agents. The first Achievement Day was held Tuesday, June 6, 1925 with 200 women in attendance.
