#### GENERAL

##### RULES:

- \* Negative Coggins required within the year. All entries need to bring the original on the day of show along with a copy that will be kept by the office.
- \* Riders/handlers must be in 3rd grade as of January 1st of the current year.
- \* All riders, regardless of age, are required to wear equine(SEI) helmets, with harness fastened when mounted.
- \* Please treat animals humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Mistreatment will be dealt with.
- \* Stallions must be handled by exhibitors 19 years and old as of January 1st of the current year.
- \* Please use the assigned numbers given with your entry.
- \* High-point awards presented Sunday in each category for rider/horse combination accumulating most points. \$2.00 per high point. Sign up by 10AM on the day of the show. Dressage is determined by average of all rides per horse and rider combination. Ties in High Point will be broken by placing in equitation.
- \* Dressage and jumping classes - a rider/horse combination can only enter 2 consecutive divisions/levels.
- \* Food and camping available on the show grounds. NO OPEN FIRES. Contact the fair office for site prior to show. Contact show office day of the show for placement.
- \* This show follows rules set forth by the US Equestrian Federation and the Wisconsin State 4-H Horse Association.
- \* Medal Classes are judged on equitation over fences on a tighter course. Elements in class can include skinny jumps, trotting a jump, halting and hand galloping.
- \* Handy Hunter is a versatility class. It must have at least two changes of direction, at least one combination and at least three of the following: hand gallop a jump, a bending line, a rollback turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or trot over one jump. Judging is based on brilliance of pace without sacrificing performance or style. Additional points are given to a handy rider. Timed obstacle. Each rider will have 45 seconds to complete their pattern. Points will be assigned to each jump. The rider will take the jumps in any order they choose. They may not jump the same jump without separating it by a different jump. If a rail is knocked down that jump is out of the rotation for that rider.
- \* Warm Up will be allowed for the full 2 minutes no matter how many rails are knocked down or refusals by t
