4-H DOG PROJECT CODE OF ETHICS

It is a privilege and an honor to be able to participate in 4-H activities and represent the Sheboygan County 4-H Clubs. PRIVILEGES ALWAYS CARRY RESPONSIBILITIES. In keeping with the philosophy that 4-H is a place for learning and social skill development, the following discipline guidelines have been established.

BEHAVIORAL STANDARDS FOR ELIGIBILITY

Parents and trainers expect 4-H participants to earn and keep the privilege of participation in dog project activities by demonstrating proper behavior and attitudes. Any unacceptable behavior will put a child's participation in jeopardy. The Dog Project Board shall determine if the unacceptable behavior should result in suspension from an activity.

SUSPENSION

The purposes of suspension are to preserve an effective atmosphere for instruction, to rehabilitate participant attitude, to protect other participants and provide a time to consult with parents. It may be imposed when other means of correction have failed or when keeping the participant in training would be detrimental to the training session.

The participant would be given three written warnings before a suspension would be enforced. Written warnings would also be mailed to participant's parents.
