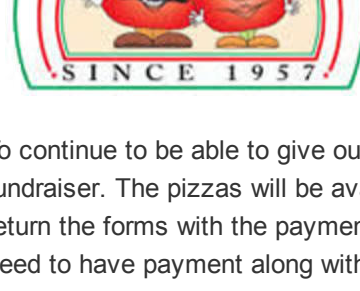

YLC Summer Trip Poll

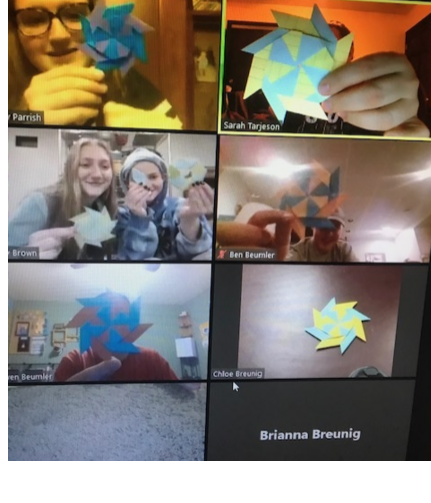

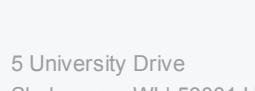
