The first place to start is with a thorough review of the materials that are available in this <u>Extension Program Policy and Approval Forms & Resources for 4-H Leaders Drive</u>. This includes the proposal for all Extension programming as well as the materials that leaders need to post, publish and follow before, during and after the program.

It is about 20 minutes and will make filling out the proposal form much easier and will point you to all you need to know to resume programming. This video must be viewed (training must be completed) by key leaders involved in the programs' proposal prior to the program being held.

After watching the video, complete <u>this short quiz/form</u> to confirm your participation. This will serve as an official record of volunteers who completed a "safety training."

I have heard many comments regarding local data regarding COVID-19 cases. I am unsure if people know how to access the latest information so I want to share it here. The following data is released every afternoon by the Sheboygan County Public Health Department, this information reflects what was shared as of Thursday afternoon:
