




We are hosting another Camp Riversite family workday. There is a lot of work to be done and this is the prime season during which to do it!


We will be working in small family units on cutting and removing invasive growth in the forest very near the campfire/bathroom area. This will be very light work!

Elections and Greenbush Recreation Area Hike




Dear 4-H youth grades 7 and up! The Youth Leadership Council forges ahead despite the challenges of our times. I have a few updates for you regarding their future plans.




4-H Leaders Association Election - Your Vote is Needed!

Sheboygan County 4-H & Salvation Army Bell Ringing




Club leaders and members – I was able to confirm that each club or group does not have to submit a proposal to Extension for each occurrence of service through Salvation Army Bell Ringing. Instead, I will complete a proposal form with the guidelines for this type of event and submit it on your behalf. The only thing you must do is [update this google document](#) with you dates and times so that I can submit an updated individual proposal for each club and occurrence so that UW-Madison Risk Division can track the number of programs that are happening in 4-H.

- A few things to keep in mind for this type of service:
- It must take place outside.
- All participants must wear a mask.
- Please limit the number of families that participate in one shift to no more than 2 families and less than 10 people.
- Please bring your own hand sanitizer and disinfectant materials if they are not provided.

As a program of the University of Wisconsin – Madison, Wisconsin 4-H prohibits discrimination in all its programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, and marital or family status. As a result, 4-H programs are focused on education and must not advance a particular religion. Explicitly or implicitly requiring religion or religious practices as a condition for participation in 4-H club meetings creates a barrier for participation and is prohibited.

An exception to this policy is that 4-H Clubs and 4-H Groups may participate in the Salvation Army's Red Kettle Campaign. Although part of the mission of the Salvation Army is to promote a specific religion, it also has a mission to meet human needs without discrimination. Since it would be impossible for the Salvation Army to specifically allocate funds of the Red Kettle Campaign by the efforts of 4-H clubs or 4-H groups, Wisconsin 4-H will assume that ALL contributions raised will be allocated to meeting human needs without discrimination.
