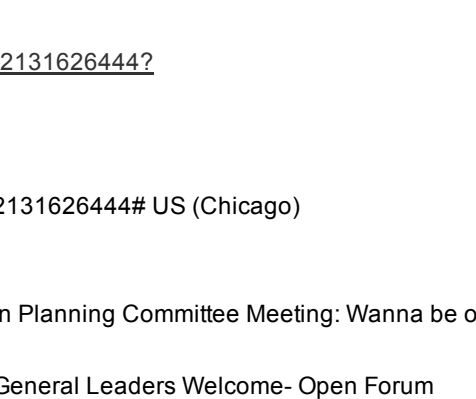

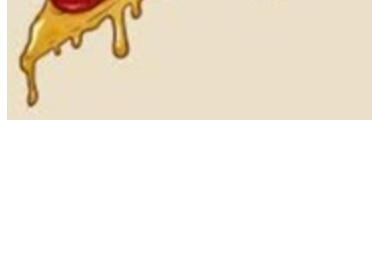
Leaders Association Meetings and More!

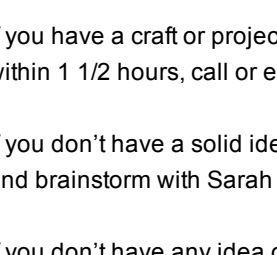
Sheboygan County VIRTUAL 4-H AWARDS AND RECOGNITION CEREMONY

If you have a craft or project idea you think you could share with a class of up to 12 4-H members within 1 1/2 hours, call or email Sarah as soon as possible.

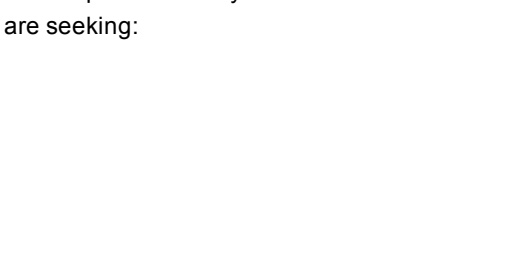
If you don't have a solid idea of which of your MANY ideas you could share, don't hesitate to call and brainstorm with Sarah as soon as possible.

If you know another older youth leader or parent or anyone creative and/or willing to share their skills, make sure they see this request for help.

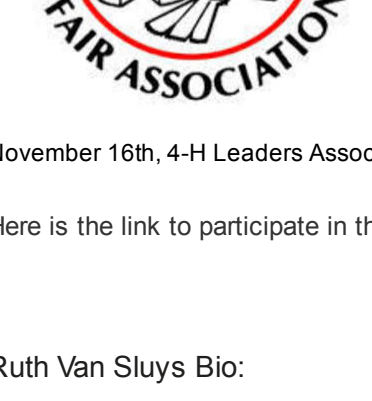

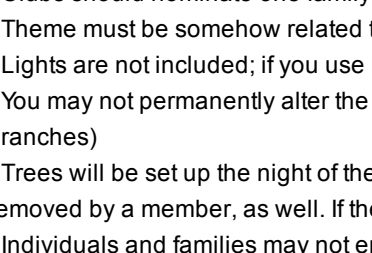

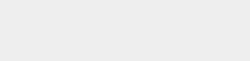
