Sheboygan County Meat Animal Sale Scholarship

Due: March 5, 2021

Description:

Up to five (5) \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility:

- a. Four years as a Sheboygan County 4-H or FFA member (may be a combination of either organization).
- b. High school seniors and currently enrolled post-secondary students currently in their first, second or third year of higher education are eligible to apply.
- c. A minimum of four years in the beef, sheep and/or swine projects (market animal or breeding stock).
- d. Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2- or 4-year college or professional technical program, Farm & Industry short course program, vocational college or training of at least one school year in length).
- e. Applicants do not need to major in agriculture.

Minimum Requirements for Application:

- a. Two letters of recommendation
 1. Project Leader or FFA advisor (quality of project work, club leadership).
 2. One from any other source (employer, teacher, school advisor) **not** from parent.
- b. Application
 1. Maximum four pages.
 2. Application must be typed. Application font size no smaller than 10 in Arial or Times New Roman font.

Interview:

- a. A panel of judges will conduct a face-to-face interview with applicants on Saturday, April 10th, 2021.

Comments:

- a. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be received at the Sheboygan County Meat Animal Sale, PO Box 115, Plymouth, WI 53073 by March 5th.
- b. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than May 1st.
- c. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school, or the school and the recipient after one semester is completed.
- d. Previous recipients of the Meat Animal Sale Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
