- 7. Paper Embroidery: Embroidering on paper can be easy and versatile. Learn how to make cool designs to turn into personalized cards or to be framed as a work of art!



**8. Fun with Foods:** Learn how to make fruit pizza, taco dip and a yummy fruit dip. Impress your friends and family with your fantastic appetizers.
