Determined by most accumulated points by horse/rider combination. Ties will be broken by placing in equitation.

Medal Classes are judged on equitation over fences on a tighter course.

Elements in class include:

- Skinny Jumps
- Trotting a Jump
- Halting
- Hand Galloping

Entry Fee - Jumping \$6 per class
Office Fee - \$5 per horse/rider combo
High Point Fee - \$5 and must be registered by
10 a.m.

Stalls - \$25 with a \$10 refund after stall is cleaned & inspected.

Shavings - \$7/bag

Handy Hunter is a versatility class. It must have a least two changes of direction, at least one combination and at least three of the following:

- Hand gallop a Jump
- Bending Line
- Rollback turn
- Fence at the End of Ring
- Trot over one Jump

Judging is based on brilliance of pace without sacrificing performance or style. Additional points are given to a handy rider.

Warm Up will be allowed for the full 2 minutes not matter how many rails are knocked down or refusals by horse.

*Negative Coggins within the calendar year must be presented at show; original is required for show, copy will be kept by show office. A copy can be emailed to schpshows@qmail.com please include horses registered name and barn name.

*Premise ID is required from exhibitors.

*All Riders are required to wear equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when mounted.

*Stallions must be handled by exhibitors 19 years and older as of the current year.

*All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from grounds for excessive barking.
