# Meeting Face-to-Face? NEW UPDATES!!!

Any meetings occurring this month, April 2021 must still complete <u>The</u> <u>Extension Program Proposal Checklist</u>. Some programs are approved

at the local level and others require approval through the state level. Please give adequate time for the approval process (at minimum 3 days).

All programs/meetings going forward must continue to maintain some form of a <u>Post</u> <u>Program Contact Log</u>. It could be this form or one of your own design, but it must include names and contact info for all participants and those present should contact tracing need to occur. This form DOES NOT need to be turned in to Sarah or anyone else – your group leadership must hold on to it.

All programs/meetings taking place after May 1 must follow the clear guidelines of Extension and local public health practices including but not limited to maintaining a social distance of 6 ft, wearing face coverings when appropriate, and maintaining proper personal hygiene. I will share the extent of these guidelines as soon as they become available.
