Outpost Camp, Wyalusing State Park

Now Approved!

Grades 7-10, July 22-25 2021

The wilderness is calling...are you up to the challenge of three nights and four days of outdoor adventure and fun! Tent camping, fire cooking, canoeing, boating, and hiking are just a few of the exciting experiences that await campers at Outpost Camp. There will also be team building and leadership development along with fun and games throughout camp...don't miss out! Outpost Camp is open to the first 30 campers grades 7-10. First priority will be given to 4-H members. Transportation to and from camp is provided by adult chaperones. Cost: \$200.

Base Camp, Camp Rokilio, Kiel, WI

Grades 3-7, August 9-12, 2021

Four days and three nights of adventure, fun, and learning. Camp Rokilio features comfortable themed sleeping quarters, a quality dining hall, archery range, swimming, fishing, and more! Programs in recreation, crafts, canoeing, nature exploration, and swimming are offered for all youth. Base Camp is open to the first 80 campers in grades 3-7. Transportation to and from camp must be provided by parents. Cost: \$200
