GIANT Yard Games at Camp Riversite!

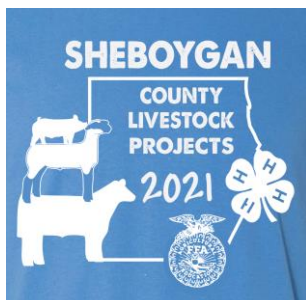

Support the Livestock Projects!

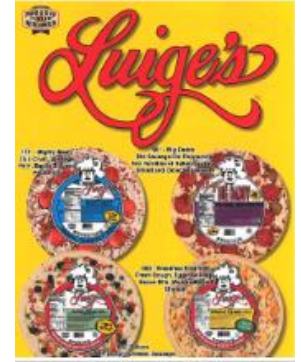
