Poultry Project - 2022

Put Your BAND numbers on Your ENTRY tags before putting them on your cage. Pick your entry tags up at the fair office before checking in your birds.

Class O: Only two lot numbers are allowed in Class O. Failure to comply will result in first two lot numbers being chosen. Remaining entries will be scratched.

All youth showing in **Class O - Blue Ribbon Animal Auction** are **REQUIRED** to do showmanship in order to be eligible to sell in the sale. You must enter on your fair entry sheet. If not entered, you will not be able to do showmanship or sell in the sale. You may use any bird that you have entered. It does not need to be the Blue Ribbon bird.

Class N - Lot 243 Decorated Eggs: Include a small card describing process used for creating eggs.

Pens must be kept clean and dry. Pens can be cleaned between 7:00 – 9:00 am and 8:30 – 9:00 pm. Ducks, geese, turkeys and large chickens should be cleaned daily. You may be asked to bring your own bedding.
