

Sheboygan County 4-H Horse & Pony Project Scholarship

Due: April 1

Description:

Up to two (2) \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility:

- a. High school seniors and post-secondary students currently in their first year of higher education are eligible to apply.
- b. A minimum GPA 3.0 out of 4.0 is required to apply.
- c. A minimum of three consecutive years in the 4-H Horse & Pony Project (regular member or horseless horse groom.
- d. Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2- o r 4-year college or professional technical program, Farm & Industry short course program, vocational college or training of at least one school year in length).
- e. Applicants may pursue any major.

Minimum Requirements for Application:

- a. Two letters of recommendation
 - 1. Project or Club Leader (quality of project work, club leadership).
 - 2. One from any other source (employer, teacher, school advisor) **not** from relative.
- b. Application

Interview:

a. A panel of judges will conduct a face-to-face interview with finalists at a date and time to be determined.

Comments:

- a. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be received at the UW-Extension Office, 5 University Drive, Sheboygan, WI 53081 by April 1.
- b. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than April 1 and recognized at the Sheboygan County Fair 4-H Horse & Pony Awards Ceremony (Monday afternoon of fair).
- c. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school, or the school and the recipient after one semester is completed.
- d. Previous recipients of the 4-H Horse & Pony Project Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
