Show Details:

- *Negative Coggins required within the year, please bring original to show office at check in. A copy can be brought the day of show (office will keep copy) OR a copy can be emailed to schpshows@gmail.com. Please write the following on coggins: barn name, riders name, premise ID.
- *Premise ID is required to show.
- *All Riders are required to wear equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when mounted.
- *Trail will be ran in parallel of other show classes. An announcement will be made with the time trail will be open at each show, there will be no running order.
- *Novice classes are based on horse/rider combination. The combination of horse and rider should not have won a blue ribbon in this class prior to today. (If a bluw ribbon was won by being the only entry in class that will not count)
- *4-H Member is open to any youth that is currently enrolled in 4-H.
- *HHG exhibitors are encouraged to enter walk/trot classes.
- *Classes will close 2 classes before the running of the class. For classes 1 and 2 they will close 15 minutes prior to the show starting.
- *Exhibitors must be ready at gate, once gate closes it is the judges discretion to allow you in the class.
- *Judges decision is final, all questions directed to judge will need to be asked at the completion of the show.
- *No studs/stallions allowed on the grounds.
- *All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from grounds for excessive barking.
