*Negative Coggins required within the year, please bring original to show office at check in. A copy can be brought the day of show (office will keep copy) OR a copy can be emailed to schpshows@gmail.com. Please write the following on coggins: barn name, riders name, premise ID.

*Premise ID is required to show.

*Sheboygan County Horse & Pony Project rules apply. Patterns are posted on the grounds to verify patterns. Ringmaster's decision is final.

*Closed Gate rules apply. Electric Timer will be used.

*Shoes with heel & SEI Equine approved helmets ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS. Short sleeve shirts are allowed, please no tank tops.

*All dogs Must be leashed & QUIET at all times. Dogs may be asked to be removed for excessive barking.

*HHG exhibitors are encouraged to enter walk/trot classes.

*Classes will close 2 classes before the running of the class. For classes 1 and 2 they will close 15 minutes prior to the show starting.

*Be ready at the gate when class is called. If exhibitbor is not at the gate by 3rd call they will be excused from the class. Tack changes will be available when needed.

*NO Studs/Stallions allowed on the grounds.

Registration:

One exhibitor number will be used for all shows for each horse/rider combinations.

A separate check will be requested for stall deposit. When stall is clean you check will be returned or shredded.
