Registrations are due May 20, 2022—Please Register Early!

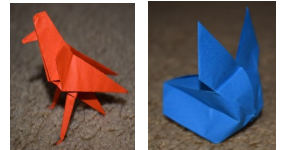

1. Quilling: come and learn the basic art of quilling! You will receive all the supplies you'll need, and together we will make the 4H four leaf clover!

2. Origami: Learn how to read folding diagrams to create your very own blow-up bunny and bird!



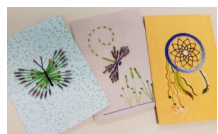
3. Intro to the Vegetable Project: Trying to decide what to take to the fair? Consider vegetables! This session will teach you how to prep veggies for a judge, and show you just what a judge is looking for. Each participant will leave with a vegetable and seeds to get started in a traditional garden or container garden. Happy growing!

4. Tissue Paper Carnations: Learn how to make beautiful flowers from tissue paper! You can make a bouquet in a vase or link the flowers together for decorative garland!
