### Jumper High Point

Determined by most accumulated points by horse/rider combination. Ties will be broken by placing in equitation.

**Medal Classes** are judged on equitation over fences on a tighter course.

Elements in class include:

- Skinny Jumps
- Trotting a Jump
- Halting
- Hand Galloping

#### **Pre-Entry is required**

Entry Fee - Jumping \$6 per class

Office Fee - \$5 per horse/rider combo

**High Point Fee** - \$5 and must be registered by 1 n m

**Stalls** - \$25 with a \$10 refund after stall is cleaned & inspected.

**Handy Hunter** is a versatility class. It must have a least two changes of direction, at least one combination and at least three of the following:

- Hand gallop a Jump
- Bending Line
- Rollback Turn
- Fence at the End of Ring
- Trot over one Jump

Judging is based on brilliance of pace without sacrificing performance or style. Additional points are given to a handy rider.

Warm Up will be allowed for the full 2 minutes not matter how many rails are knocked down or refusals by horse.
