### Pre-Entry is required

**Entry Fee** - Jumping \$6 per class

**Office Fee** - \$5 per horse/rider combo

**High Point Fee** - \$5 and must be registered by  
1 p.m.

**Stalls** - \$25 with a \$10 refund after stall is  
cleaned & inspected.

**Handy Hunter** is a versatility class. It  
must have a least two changes of  
direction, at least one combination and  
at least three of the following:

- Hand gallop a Jump
- Bending Line
- Rollback Turn
- Fence at the End of Ring
- Trot over one Jump

Judging is based on brilliance of pace  
without sacrificing performance or style.  
Additional points are given to a handy  
rider.

**Medal Classes** are judged  
on equitation over fences  
on a tighter course.

Elements in class include:

- Skinny Jumps
- Trotting a Jump
- Halting
- Hand Galloping

**Warm Up will be allowed for the full 2 minutes not matter how  
many rails are knocked down or refusals by horse.**

**\*Negative Coggins** within the calendar year must be presented at show; original is  
required for show, copy will be kept by show office. A copy can be emailed to  
[schpshows@gmail.com](mailto:schpshows@gmail.com) please include horses registered name and barn name.

**\*Premise ID** is required from exhibitors.

**\*All Riders** are required to wear equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when  
mounted.

**\*Stallions** must be handled by exhibitors 19 years and older as of the current year.

**\*All dogs** on the grounds must be on a leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from  
grounds for excessive barking.
