# **Show Details:**

**Negative Coggins** is required within the year, please bring original to show office at check in. A copy can be brought the day of the show (office will keep copy) OR a copy can be emailed to schpshows@gmail.com. Please write the following on coggins: barn name, riders name, premise ID.

**Premise ID** is required to show.

All Riders are required to wear equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when mounted.

\*Novice classes are based on horse/rider combination. The combination of horse and rider should not have won a blue ribbon in this class prior to today. (If a blue ribbon was won by being the only entry in the class that will not count)

\*4-H Member classes are open to any youth that are currently enrolled in 4-H, no matter the county.

\*HHG exhibitors are encouraged to enter walk/trot classes.

\*Classes will close 2 classes before the running of a class. For classes 1 and 2, they will close 15 minutes prior to the show starting.

\*Exhibitors must be ready at the gate, once the gate closes it is the judge's discretion to allow exhibitor in the class.

\*The judge's decision is final, all questions directed to the judge will need to be asked at the completion of the show.

\*No studs/stallions allowed on the grounds.

\*All dogs on the grounds must be on leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from the grounds for excessive barking.
