Show Details:

Negative Coggins is required within the year, please bring original to show office at check in. A copy can be brought the day of the show (office will keep copy) OR a copy can be emailed to schpshows@gmail.com. Please write the following on coggins: barn name, riders name, premise ID.

Premise ID is required to show.

*Sheboygan County Horse & Pony rules apply. Patterns are posted on the grounds to verify patterns. Ringmaster's decision is final.

ALL RIDERS are required to wear shoes with heels and equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when mounted.

*Closed Gate rules apply. Electric Timer will be used.

*HHG exhibitors are encouraged to enter walk/trot classes.

*Be ready at the gate when class is called. If exhibitor is not at the gate by the 3rd call you will be excused from the class. Tack changes will be available when needed.

*No studs/stallions allowed on the grounds.

stAll dogs on the grounds must be on leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from the grounds for excessive barking.

*Turn & Burn and Speed Barrels will run every other show. May & July will be Speed Barrels; June & August will be Turn & Burn.
