It is VERY important that you are respectful to your coach, their horse, your parents, and your 4-H leaders.
- We cannot guarantee that we will be able to match you to a coach for the current 4-H year. In the event we aren't able to pair you with a coach, we will do our best to create opportunities for you to get some experience handling a horse.
