- **Negative Coggins** within the calendar year must be presented at show; original is required for show, copy will be kept by show office.
- **Premise ID** is required from exhibitors.
- All riders are required to wear equine (SEI) helmets, with chin strap fastened when mounted.
- No Stallions allowed on the grounds.
- All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash. Dogs may be asked to be removed from grounds for excessive barking.
- SCHP committee reserves the right to excuse any horse considered dangerous.

High Point is determined by the most accumulated points by horse/rider combination by division. Ties will be broken by placing in equitation.

Medal Classes are judges on equitation over fences on a tighter course. Can include skinny jumps, trotting a jump, halting & hand galloping.

Handy Hunter is a versatility class. It must have at least two changes of direction, at least one combination and at least three of the following: Hand gallop a jump, bending line, rollback turn, fence at the end of the ring, trot over one jump. Judging is based on the brilliance of pace without sacrificing performance or style. Additional points are given to a handy rider.

Warmups will be allowed for the full 2 minutes no matter how many rails are knocked down or refusals by horse.
