Responsibilities Participate in meetings of the committee.

Become informed on issues or business to be discussed.

Express opinions clearly and allow others to express theirs.

Accept responsibilities and share the workload.

Accept decisions of the majority.

Fulfill committee assignments.

Report back to a larger group.

Time Required Time for committee meetings (meetings are commonly the 4th Monday monthly) 6:00 pm for the youth committee and 6:30 pm for the full committee.
